BREITHORN

Plenty of variety in summer and winter!

The Breithorn is a five-peaked, heavily glaciated mountain ridge in the Valais Alps, running from west to east. The highest point of the ridge and also the easiest four-thousander in the Alps to climb is the western summit (main summit, Breithorn Occidentale, 4,164 metres above sea level).

Climbing the Breithorn in a group costs CHF 225 per person (minimum 3 people).

Climbing the Breithorn with a private mountain guide costs from CHF 660.

FREERIDE

Surrounded by mighty four-thousand-metre peaks, Zermatt offers a world where only one thing matters: the feeling of absolute freedom. As soon as you make your first turns in the untouched deep snow, you will feel this unique mixture of lightness and adrenaline. Your gaze wanders over rugged peaks, the Matterhorn towers majestically into the sky – and you glide through the middle of this alpine wonderland.

Freeriding in a group costs CHF 200.00 per person (minimum 4 people).
